

The LKY School is currently seeking applications for three programmes:

1. **Master in Public Policy (MPP):** This two-year programme is designed for young professionals with 1 to 5 years of work experience, who seek rigorous education and training in public affairs. The programme provides a strong foundation in policy analysis, programme evaluation, and management in the public, private and not-for-profit sectors. Graduates acquire knowledge and skills that enable them to work in many settings, from national, state, and local government, to think-tanks, consulting firms, multilateral institutions, and community-action groups. Additionally, select MPP students can qualify to benefit from a number of double degree and exchange programmes with internationally renowned institutions such as Columbia SIA, LSE, Sciences Po, University of Tokyo and many more.
2. **Master in Public Administration (MPA):** This one-year programme provides an intensive, inter-disciplinary course of study specially tailored for public service officials with at least 5 years of work experience. The focus of the curriculum is on enhancing the officials' effectiveness to work on increasingly complex issues shaping national, regional, and global policies and projects. Graduates of MPA acquire knowledge and skills to enhance their leadership and managerial capabilities to work in the public, private, and not-for-profit sectors.
3. **Lee Kuan Yew Fellows Master in Public Management (MPM):** This is a highly distinguished one-year programme for a select group of 20 to 25 senior government officials and professionals in Asia with more than 8 years of work experience and a proven track record of leadership, high-level decision making, and a strong commitment to public service in their respective countries. Every year, the MPM LKY Fellows come together in the presence of renowned international experts to debate, analyze, and share ideas on how to deal with the challenges in public policy and their management through effective leadership and good governance. The MPM programme provides a unique opportunity for public service officials from across Asia to study for one semester at the LKY School, and a second at either the Harvard Kennedy School or Columbia University's School of International & Public Affairs (SIPA). They also benefit from a five-week attachment to a government ministry or statutory board, related to their field of expertise.
