



## Master Degree of Law (LL.M.)

(The LL.M. in U.S., International & Transnational  
Law at CMU & CK)

### The structure of the Program:

#### The 1<sup>st</sup> Option -

The first semester, consisting of 4 legal courses, is taught at CMU. Upon completion with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.7, the students will be awarded 'the Certificate', and 10 credits of advanced standing towards the second semester at CK to complete the remaining 14 credits.

#### The 2<sup>nd</sup> Option -

At CMU, the students will study 2 compulsory courses, and are required to pass them with the GPA 2.7. The students will then spend 2 semesters at CK for the remaining credits towards the LL.M. Degree at CK. There will be no certificate given.

## LL.M Degree awarded by Chicago-Kent College of Law

### 4 Legal courses:

#### 2 compulsory courses

- Introduction to the American Legal System
- Introduction to Legal Research and Writing

**2 other courses** (may not be repeated immediately in the following year)

- Overview of Intellectual Property Law
- Business Organizations & International Business Transactions



### Requirements:

English proficiency test score:

- IELTS 6.5 or TOEFL equivalence 573 (paper), 230 (computer), 89 (internet)
- IELTS 6.0 + compulsory English classes at CMU (with charge of 100USD/month)

Eligible applicants:

- Last year undergraduates of the law degree
- LL.B. graduates (with or without a license to practice law)
- Only 20 prospective students will be accepted to the Program

### Tuition Fees (excluding room and board):

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Option –

4,900USD at CMU, and 21,000USD at CK  
(OR 4,900USD at CMU + 26,100 USD at CK for 2 semesters)

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Option –

2,900USD at CMU, and 26,100USD at CK for 2 semesters

### Application date:

Admission announcement – ASAP  
Now – early November 2014  
(Late applications may be considered)



### Other advantages:

Spending a full academic year in Chicago entitles the students under U.S. immigration regulations to apply for Optional Practical Training, which if granted by the authorities entitles students to work or obtain an internship for one year in Chicago after graduation. Further, two Chicago-Kent semesters qualifies students to sit for the New York Bar Examination .
