The research clarifies the fundamental theoretical issues about land use planning and land use planning legislation; analyzes, identifies the international experience of some countries in the field of legislation adjustment on land use planning, creating an important basis for contacting, assessing the current law and consulting in the process of finalizing legislation on land use planning; assesses, analyzes the implementation of legislation on land use planning in ThuaThien Hue and points out the specific regional factors in planning activities to improve legislation and ensure the enforcement in Thua Thien Hue; analyzes the requirements and directions for improving legislation on land use planning in Vietnam, making a specific interpretation on the scientific and practical basis to ensure the implementation of legislation on land use planning contributing to socio- economic sustainable development as well as ensuring peculiarity of land use planning in Vietnam.
